

Kibale National Park

The Kibale National Park evolved from a former forest reserve and received National Park status in **1993**. It is spread **over 766 sq km** at an altitude ranging from **1,000 m and 1,600 m**.

Although it is closely located to the Queen Elisabeth National Park, it **has its particularities**. Almost 80% of its area is covered by **indigenous evergreen wet-forests** and deciduous forests. **Swamps** and grassland dominate the rest. Due to the high percentage of forest, **chimpanzee trekking** has a high success rate.

To reach the park by car is easy. From **nearby Fort Portal** leads a track into the Park. A visit is possible through out the year, but during the rainy season between April/May and October/November you have to expect some chilly nights.

At the tourist centre of Kanyanchu there are **wooden huts and camping sites**. In the nearby towns of Nkingo and Bigodi are hotels at your disposal, for example the Ndali Lodge.
